



Ohio Origin – Destination Trips SURFACE TRAVEL ON AN AVERAGE DAY



Population Projection





Age Demographics





Population 65 Years & Older




Disability Rate

Ohio Disability Rate: 13.9%




Disabled Population

State of Ohio - Households Below Poverty Line -17.6%




Individuals Below Poverty

State of Ohio - Individuals Below Poverty Rate: 14.5%



Zero Vehicle Households




